Attaining the rank of Eagle is special at any time! BUT, receiving your Eagle award at the National Jamboree (especially the 100th anniversary of Scouting) is extra special, for sure!

So, one of the councils of the BSA has created a very unique patch to encourage the lifetime memory of the Eagle rank and to recognize scouts who will receive Eagle at Fort A. P. Hill during the National Jamboree. Only those scouts who will attain Eagle and their SMs who's troops hold an Eagle Court of Honor at the National Jamboree are eligible to receive this once-in-a-lifetime [Lucasfilm](http://www.lucasfilm.com) authorized Yoda Eagle patch. Please note that only one patch is available per qualified recipient.

The Yoda Eagle patch features unprecedented color and detail, is highly collectible and will help make your Eagle Court of Honor even more exciting. These patches are available for Eagle Scouts in any council.

How do I get a Yoda Eagle Patch?

Your Scout Master must contact Glen Calkins via email at gcalkins@gmail.com and provide the names of the scout recipients with the dates of their Eagle Board of Review, Jamboree SM and Jamboree troop number. Then, your Troop must hold a commemorative Eagle Court of Honor at the National Jamboree where your Scout Master can present, along with the coveted Eagle award, your Yoda Eagle patch! Please note that receiving an Eagle at the National Jamboree doesn't have to replace your Troop's or family Eagle Ceremony - you can have it all! You earned it!

Did you know...

Scouts from 26 nations attended the National Jamboree in 2005.

The National Scout Jamboree has been held in Washington DC, Pennsylvania, California, Colorado, Idaho, and Virginia.

During the 2005 Jamboree, scouts consumed 13,500 boxes of cereal, 43,000 gallons of milk, 3.5 tons of hot dogs, 8.5 tons of hamburgers, 195,000 eggs and 21,000 loaves of bread.

Did you know... since 1937, more than 654,000 scouts and leaders have experienced the National Jamboree.

The first scheduled BSA National Jamboree was canceled because of a polio outbreak in Washington

We just got a BSA Jamboree catalog that has all these Jamboree items in it. Do we have to buy anything from it?

No, you do not have to buy a single thing from that catalog. It contains all kinds of Jamboree-related memorabilia items that you can purchase if you want some of them. This will be the only offering of these items. Once Jamboree is over with, all these items are gone.
